CAIRNS

PALM COVE

PORT DOUGLAS

With its intimate village atmosphere, Port Douglas, an hour north of Cairns, is perfect to handle larger conferences.

Hotel and resort conference facilities in Port Douglas can cater for up to 850 theatre style, and it is a regular occurrence for the whole town to pull together to stage these large meetings, by using conferencing facilities of the Sheraton Mirage, with delegates being accommodated across other properties.

TROPICAL ISLANDS

A short 40-minute boat ride away, Green and Fitzroy Islands are ideal for smaller residential meetings or day activities.
