Having recently celebrated 20 successful years of operation, the Cairns Convention Centre is a flagship venue in Cairns & Great Barrier Reef region, catering for up to 5,000 delegates and attracting a variety of international conferences, corporate meetings, industry exhibitions, and large scale sporting and entertainment events.

Winner of the AIPC World's Best Congress Centre Award in 2004 and 2014 and set to undergo an AUD \$176 million refurbishment and expansion beginning in 2020, the acclaimed Cairns Convention Centre is an international standard, purpose-built venue located amidst an atmosphere and environment that the rest of the world envies.

The Centre has hosted world leaders for the Pacific Island Forum and APEC meetings, Nobel Laureates at the International Conference on Atomic Physics, international travel professionals for the 2014 Australian Tourism Exchange (ATE14) and Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors as part of the G20 delegation visiting Australia in 2014.

More recently, the Centre welcomed prominent scientists from various disciplines during the International Society for Horticultural Science Meeting, the Australian & New Zealand Orthopaedic Association Annual Scientific Meeting and the International Conference on Electromagnetics in Advance Applications and IEEE-APS Topical Conference on Antennas and Propagation in Wireless Communications, all providing a forum for thought leaders to share ideas and knowledge leading to future progress and innovation in diverse, cutting-edge industries.
