


THE NATURAL PLACE TO MEET




PALM COVE

TROPICAL ISLANDS

Green Island, the Great Barrier Reef's largest sand cay, is a 45-minute boat transfer away from Cairns and features a luxury eco-resort with 46 accommodation rooms.

Fitzroy Island, also a quick 40-minutes from Cairns, boasts rainforest and reef activities, plus accommodation and conference facilities for an hassle-free event off the mainland.

The exclusive and incredibly luxurious 5-star resort on Lizard Island, catering for smaller groups up to 80, is easily accessible by air from Cairns or Cooktown and provides the perfect incentive option.

For day options, the Frankland Islands are the closest collection to the Cairns mainland located only 10km offshore and Dunk Island, nestled off the shore of Mission Beach, is only a short water-taxi, ferry or kayak journey away.
