Located just 7 kilometers from Cairns CBD.





Domestic Terminal Upgrade

Cairns Airport's \$55 million Domestic Terminal Upgrade was completed in August 2020. The new-look terminal provides an improved passenger experience and instantly connects travellers to Tropical North Queensland.

The terminal upgrade saw the departure lounge double in size to 10,000sqm and now boasts more local produce, giftware and iconic local brands than ever before.

With reconfigured boarding gates, additional seating and an improved terminal layout, the upgrade has delivered an authentic new airport experience.


